



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Belarusian State University, Belarus

and

Xidian University, China

Belarusian State University, Belarus and Xidian University, China (hereafter referred to as “both universities”) enter into the following terms of agreement with respect to furthering technical exchanges and thus deepening the friendship between both universities.

1. Based on the principles of mutual benefit, both universities intend to explore opportunities for cooperating in the following areas:
 - a. Visits by and interchange of faculty and scholars between both universities for the purposes of research, teaching and development;
 - b. Exchange of students between both universities for the purposes of training, internship, and other activities;
 - c. Exchange of information, experience and knowledge of academic fields (including research publications, teaching materials and library materials), where each party respects copyright and intellectual property rights;
 - d. Other exchange activities that both universities agree to.
2. Specific projects and activities under this agreement may be developed as per agreement by both universities. Details of such projects and activities


may, from time to time, be provided by annexes to this agreement.

3. Both universities will negotiate on the matter of the travel and living expenses of each exchanged teacher, researcher, administrator and student.

4. This agreement will come into effect for a period of 5 years from the date of signature by the presidents of both universities.

5. The terms of this agreement may be revised or modified at any time through joint review and proposals by both universities. This agreement can be terminated unilaterally by either of the universities upon submitting the request for its cancellation in writing six months in advance.
