

**Memorandum of Understanding on Teaching Cooperation
between Zhejiang Ocean University and Belarusian State University**

In accordance with the agreement about teaching and scientific research to be signed by Zhejiang Ocean University and Belarusian State University on July 9, 2006, the following memorandum of teaching cooperation is achieved after further negotiation:

Article 1

According to this memo, both Parties shall endeavor to obtain the support from their own government so as to make this project one of the cooperative programs between two countries.

Article 2

Zhejiang Ocean University will send 20 students to Belarusian State University since 2007 on the principle of similar specialties. These students are junior students. They will spend one year in Belarusian State University to learn Russian. After that, they can study the master's program directly. When they graduate, they will get the undergraduate Diploma issued by Zhejiang Ocean University and the postgraduate Diploma issued by Belarusian State University. Belarusian State University will be responsible for the tuition fees of these 10 students except for international travel charge. 10 more students will be responsible for the tuition by themselves according to the special agreement.

Article 3

Belarusian State University will send 10 students to Zhejiang Ocean University since 2007 on the principle of similar specialties. These students are junior students. They will study in Zhejiang Ocean University for one year and then will get the undergraduate Diploma issued by Belarusian State University. Zhejiang Ocean University will be responsible for the tuition fees of these 10 students except for international travel charge.

Article 4

Belarusian State University has the possibility to send a number of students to Zhejiang Ocean University to attend the one-year special program to learn Chinese. The fees shall be taken on by Belarusian State University.


Article 5

In order to further strengthen both Parties' teaching cooperation, both Parties will send 1 to 3 teachers reciprocally to teach language. Their fees will be paid by the counterpart university except for the international travel charge taken on by their own university.

In term of this memo, both Parties shall assign the concrete departments and experts to carry out this project so as to make out the more specific work schemes as soon as possible.
