



Supplementary Student Exchange Agreement
between
Belarusian State University
and
Kookmin University



Following the principals of the Memorandum of Understanding Belarusian State University, represented by its Rector Prof. Sergey V. Ablameyko, and Kookmin University, represented by its President Dr. Sung Woo Lee, agree to promote academic cooperation between two universities as follows:

1. Each University will make an effort to promote mutual cooperation in the following activities upon the principles of equality and reciprocity.
 - (1) Exchange of academic materials and publications
 - (2) Exchange of faculty members
 - (3) Conducting joint research activities and organizing symposiums
 - (4) Exchange of both undergraduate and graduate students
 - (5) Any other exchange issues will become effective upon approval of both parties

2. Exchange Program
 - (1) Number of Exchange Students
Each institution may send and accept under this program no more than 4 (four) students each academic year, 2 (two) students per semester. The institutions undertake to balance the numbers of students from each institution each year. With the agreement of the host institution, the number of students in a particular year may exceed two where it is necessary to “balance” the numbers of exchange students in a particular year. Both institutions envision various methods of maintaining balance, such as summer programs, short exchanges, and similar brief interchanges.
 - (2) Statue of Exchange Students
Each institution shall normally accept incoming exchange students as non-degree or graduate special students (i.e. students who do not intend to obtain a degree or other formal qualification from the host university during the exchange period.)
 - (3) Admission Procedures
The students participating in the exchange program under the terms of this Agreement shall be selected initially by the home institution, and the host institution shall make the final admission decision in each case.
 - (4) Academic Record and Accreditation
The host institution shall evaluate the academic performance of each exchange student according to its rules and shall send the home institution the academic record/transcript of each exchange student. The home institution may give credit to each student according to its regulations.

(5) Tuition, Fees, and Expenses

Exchange students shall not be required to pay admission application and tuition fees at the host institution, and provided they have paid the appropriate tuition and fees to their home institution. Under the principle of reciprocity, exchange students can accommodate in dormitories of the host institution without payment. All other fees and costs (international travel, health insurance, mandatory fees, books, supplies, meals, and other incidental expenses arising out of the exchange) will be the responsibility of the exchange student. The host institution will assist the exchange student to find initial accommodation wherever necessary.

3. Specific details of exchanges noted above and all financial arrangements are to be negotiated by the program coordinator from both institution each year upon consultation among concerned faculty and staff. Deadlines for application are determined by each institution.

4. This Agreement will be effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of the universities. It shall be subject to review in four years and may be extended automatically by mutual agreement between two universities. Either university reserves the right to terminate it by mutual consent or upon six months written notice to the other.

5. Carrying out activity within the framework of the present agreement, the parties will observe the legislation of Korea and Belarus. Disputes arising under this agreement shall be resolved through discussions and negotiations between the parties.

6. The agreement is drawn up in two identical copies in English.
