

**Memorandum of Understanding on Co-operation
between
Belarusian State University
and
COMSATS Institute of Information Technology**

The Belarusian State University and COMSATS Institute of Information Technology, mentioned below «Parties»,

furthering development of international cooperation in the field of education, science and technology for promoting capacity building, human resource and to be of mutual advantage of both Institutes, agree on the following:

Article 1

Parties on the basis of equality and mutual interests will develop the following forms of cooperation:

- exchange of students for training at all levels (undergraduate, Master and post-graduate programs) for up to a semester of study;
- faculty members exchange;
- research scholars visit of up to three weeks to work on specific research projects on both sides;
- exchange of information, teaching materials and scientific reports;
- organising conferences, seminars, workshops and courses;
- joint publications.

Article 2

Priority will be given to the following areas of study:

- Mathematics;
- Physics;
- Chemistry;

- Economics.

This MoU does not exclude other forms of cooperation that can be proposed for discussion by any Party.

All changes of the MoU cannot be realized without written notification of the Parties.

Article 3

Financial terms of any activity in the frame of this MoU shall be determined in the additional papers on the basis of available financial resources.

It's possible to involve other organizations and funds to finance the cooperation.

The main principles of financing are the following:

- the host Party shall release from University tuition and accommodation fees

- the home Party shall bear medical insurance, travel and other expenses

- Master's and PhD scholarships for Belarusian students into CIIT programs and for CIIT young scholars into Belarusian institutions to promote mutual human resource development.

Article 4

This MoU will come into force on the date of signature by the corresponding authorities and will be effective as an ongoing MoU with no set time frame.

Each Party can terminate this MoU by written notification of another Party not later than 6 months before the ending of relations.

Article 5

Carrying out activity within the framework of the present MoU, the parties will observe the legislation of Pakistan and Belarus.

Disputes arising under this MoU shall be resolved through discussions and negotiations between the parties.

The MoU is drawn up in two identical copies in English.
