

In order to further promote the undertakings of the education of foreign students in Heilongjiang province, the Heilongjiang provincial government has established the “International Scholarship Students under the Heilongjiang Provincial Government Scholarship” program. This program is aiming to support Heilongjiang Provincial colleges and universities designated to recruit international students who come for undergraduate and postgraduate studies. Harbin University of Science and Technology (HUST) is admitting international students under Heilongjiang Provincial Government Scholarship Program.

Harbin University of Science and Technology is a teaching and research university based on science and engineering, and with coordinated development of nine disciplines of economics, management, philosophy, literature, law, education and art. The university has 18 schools, 63 undergraduate majors; 22 first-level disciplines authorized by master degree, 98 second-level disciplines authorized by master degree; 8 first-level disciplines authorized by doctor degree, and 28 second-level disciplines authorized by doctor degree.

Applicants can choose the majors they want to study in the university major catalog. The Heilongjiang Provincial Government Scholarship Program does not provide free Chinese language tutoring. It requires that applicant must have the HSK Level 5 Chinese language certificate for applying for the scholarship. If the applicant has no basic knowledge of Chinese, applicant can study Chinese at the School of International Culture and Education of our university (learning expense at applicant’s own expense). After obtaining the HSK Level 5 certificate, the applicant can enter into professional studies. Applicants applying for the undergraduate program of Chinese International Education do not need to provide HSK score certificate or Chinese language tutoring.

1. Enrollment category

Undergraduate and postgraduate programs.

2. Enrollment quota

Undergraduate: 7; Master: 3; Ph.D.: undetermined.

3. Details of the Scholarship

Exempt from registration fee, tuition fee, fee for laboratory experiment, fee for internship, intramural accommodation and comprehensive medical insurance;

Note:

(1) Costs of the laboratory experiment or internship that beyond the university’s arrangements should be afforded by the students themselves.

(2) International travel cost and living expense are NOT covered by the scholarship.

4. Eligibility

(1) Applicants must be non-Chinese nationals in good health and cannot be helped with any other coinciding scholarships.

(2) Applicants must not be currently studying in Chinese universities(The students who have graduated from Chinese universities for more than one academic year are allowed).

(3) Education background and age limit:

- Applicants for bachelor program study must hold high school diploma and be under the age of 25

- Applicants for master program study must hold bachelor degree diploma and be under the age of 35.

- Applicants for Ph.D. program study must hold master degree diploma and be under the age of 40.

5. Application documents

The applicants must fill in and provide the following materials truly and correctly (two copies in duplicate).

(1)Application of Heilongjiang Provincial Government Scholarship Form, completed in either Chinese or English both accepted.

(2)Highest diploma (notarized photocopy). If applicants are university students or already employed, they should also provide documents of being university students or on-post employees. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English.

(3) Student records and HSK records.

(4)Student studying and research plan. Applicants can use either Chinese or English to give a detailed report about their study and research plan (enclose documents).

(5)Applicants for postgraduate program must provide at least two recommendation letters from professors or associate professors in either English or Chinese.

(6)Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form (printed by Chinese quarantine authority and only for those whose period of studies in China lasts up to six months) filled in English. The medical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. The medical examination results will be valid for 6 months. All applicants are kindly requested to take this factor into consideration while determining the time to take the medical examination.

(7) Passport duplication copy.

6. Application Process

1. To view the university's programs catalog, you can log on the university website <http://www.hrbust.edu.cn/>, then click on Enrollment and employment --select Programs settings--determine the program you want to study;

2. Fill out the "Heilongjiang Provincial Government Scholarship Application Form" and prepare all application materials;

3. The electronic version of the application materials should be sent **by the authorized person at your university** to the registration email: jiyongjin69@163.com, and the original application materials(hard copies) shall be delivered to Department of International Cooperation and Exchanges of Harbin University of Science and Technology (postcode: 150080), No.52 Xuefu Road, Nangang Dist., Harbin, China.

Note: Applicant materials will not be returned.

8. Examination Method

1. Harbin University of Science and Technology will review the application documents;
2. A Face to face or virtual interview will be conducted to the applicants

9. Admission and Notice

(1)Applicants may check the admission results via emails : jiyongjin69@163.com, 1059753680@qq.com.

(2)Harbin University of Science and Technology will receive and prepare admission documents for the admitted applicants.

(3) The admission list will be published at <http://gjhz.hrbust.edu.cn/> in early July;

(4)Admitted applicants will receive their "Admission Notice", "Enrollment Instructions", and "visa application form for study in China" (JW202) at the end of July (estimatly). The admitted students must apply for student visa and arrive at HUST, finalizing register by the end of August (usually) as requested.
