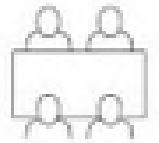

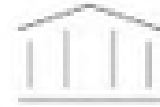
LEIPZIG ATMOSPHERE

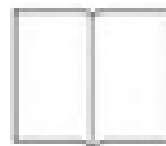
SEMESTER DATES

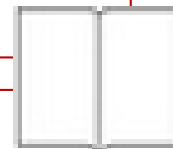

A course (=Modul in German) has 10 ECTS credits



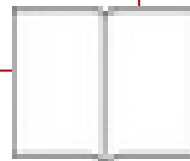

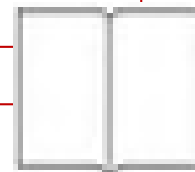

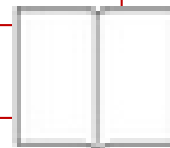
